DDA - CHEYNES POLICY

Cheynes vision is a society where everyone can participate fully on equal terms regardless of disability. We are committed to challenge prejudice against disabled people and we will continue to develop policy, procedures and practices to actively deal with discrimination.

Access Statement: Cheynes Next Generation

The salon has a full range of facilities for disabled visitors including dedicated disabled parking close to the entrance to the building; ramp access into the building; automatic external doors; lift access to the first floor salon; very wide corridors; excellent lighting throughout the building; level floor area in all parts of the salon; a dedicated disabled toilet within the building situated on the ground floor a short distance from the salon.
